

NACH Agency Good Standing Requirements for NOFA Participation

Sub-proposals will be eligible from organizations/agencies which are:

- a. Located and operate within the Alabama counties of Madison, Morgan and Limestone.
- b. Are providing and intend to provide support and/or shelter to homeless persons.
- c. Are a designated IRS 501c3 organization
- d. Possess a current DUNS number.
- e. Have been an active member of NACH since January 1, 2012. All active members must have a 70% attendance at the monthly NACH Agency Meetings
- f. Membership dues are up-to-date.
- g. All applicants must be compliant with current Federal-Local and State Funds. Applicants may be required to provide documentation of current and past audits. All deficiencies or findings must have been resolved in order to be eligible for NOFA Participation.
- h. Uses HMIS to keep records accurate and up to date.

NACH Agency Proposal Selection Process

Upon NOFA notification from HUD the NACH Executive Director will forward the funding announcement to all NACH Agency Members. If new funding is available the NACH Agency Members will be given the opportunity to present their proposal to the NACH Agency Members in a Special Call Meeting or at the regular NACH Agency Monthly Meeting. (This date will be determined by the Executive Director) The Agency members will be given the opportunity to vote on a designated number of applicants which will be allowed to make a presentation to the NACH Board of Directors. The NACH Board of Director will select an applicant for NOFA participation based on the current needs of the community, the applicant's capacity to administer the awarded funds and the applicant's ability to provide the required match funds. Once the selected agency has been determined all applicants will be notified in writing of the outcome of their proposal.
