MADISON COUNTY HAS BEEN AWARDED ADDITIONAL FEDERAL FUNDS AVAILABLE THROUGH THE EMERGENCY FOOD AND SHELTER PROGRAM (EFSP) from FEMA and the CARES Act.

**ANNOUNCEMENT FROM MANAGEMENT AGENCY UNDER
THE EMERGENCY FOOD AND SHELTER NATIONAL BOARD PROGRAM**

Madison County has been chosen to receive \$100,777.00 to supplement emergency food and shelter programs in Madison County in 2021.

Under the terms of the grant from the National Board, local agencies chosen to receive funds must:

- 1) be private voluntary non-profits or units of government,
- 2) be eligible to receive Federal funds,
- 3) have an accounting system,
- 4) practice nondiscrimination,
- 5) have demonstrated the capability to deliver emergency food and/or shelter programs, and
- 6) if they are a private voluntary organization, have a voluntary board.
