

## Modestly Funded Huntsville Ranks 26<sup>th</sup> in the Nation Besting State Peers

The National Homeless Information Project has ranked the North Alabama Continuum of Care (CoC) 26<sup>th</sup> out of 273 Small City sister CoCs in the 2017 System Performance Measures collected annually by HUD. The following measures were used:

SPM1 – Median days to exit homelessness from Emergency Shelter (ES) or Transitional Housing (TH).

SPM2 - Number of people who exited to Permanent Housing (PH) and then returned to homelessness, otherwise known as recidivism.

SPM4 - Number of CoC program leavers with income increases at exit.

SPM7.1 – Percentage of successful exits to PH from ES, TH, and Rapid Rehousing.

SPM7.2 – Successful exit to PH or retention in PH for CoC-funded PH.
